*Co-Op may be attained in increments of 1, 2 or 3 credit hours by registering for COE 111, COE 121, COE 112, COE 122, or COE 113 (the second digit indicating the first or second in the series and the last digit indicating the number of credit hours). Note: 1 credit hours of Co-Op during a 10 week summer term equates to 16 hours of work per week.

Cooperative education or an equivalent is required for graduation. Students must have completed a minimum of 14 credit-hours in the core courses, obtain approval from the dean, and must pre-register with the Co-Op Office. One credit-hour of COE equates to 160 hours of work experience.
